



Racial Justice and Inclusion in Coaching A deep exploration for coaches

Psychosynthesis Trust, London 22nd June 2023 1000-1700

In May 2022, Paul Elliott and Nana-Efua Lawson jointly ran an exploratory half day workshop on the issue of Racial Justice and Equity in Coaching. Following on from this Paul Elliott with Dr Saiyyidah Zaidi are now facilitating a follow up full day workshop to explore the issue in more depth.

In the May 2022 workshop, we were informed by and worked with the Manifesto for Racial Justice and Equity in Coaching written by Charmaine Roche and Jonathan Passmore in October 2021. An updated version of the report with further research has now been published in 2023 by the same authors entitled "We don't see Colour: How executive coaching can help leaders to create inclusive cultures by acknowledging structural racism."

In this workshop we will once again hold a psychosynthetic context for the discussion, exploring our individual perspectives and experience. We will explore some of the barriers and resistance to this work and provide guidance and methods of how to help coaching clients with a range of ethnic heritages to thrive in cultures that are colourblind and therefore systemically racist. We will contextually frame this work in the broader issue of diversity, inclusion and belonging in coaching and will call on and work with the experiences of participants and provide a safe inclusive space for a broad range of people.
