

PGC PLC Programme for 2023 and 2024

Core learning elements – the six units

- 1: Foundations of psychosynthesis coaching the foundations of psychosynthesis coaching: principles and context, approach and method, models and skills
- 2: **Coaching psychology** the evolution of psychology within coaching; the model of psychospiritual development; working at three psychological levels: prepersonal, personal and transpersonal; in three psychological spaces: coach, client and coaching spaces



- 3: **Coaching interventions** intervention theory and Heron's six-category intervention analysis; somatic experience in coaching; working with mindsets and subpersonalities as psychosynthesis coaches
- 4: **Leadership and organisational systems** the leadership context; working with inner and outer agendas, including purpose and meaning, crisis and change; introduction to organisational systems, systemic coaching and constellations
- 5: **Leadership development** introduction to leadership development; horizontal, vertical and inner development; 5DL Five Dimensions of Leadership, our model of inner leader development; interventions, tools and resources to support leader development
- 6: **Professional practice** practical, personal and professional challenges of coaching; finding your professional identity and building your practice.

Scheduled PGCPLC Programmes

Advanced Professional Development Programmes for coaches and leaders. Each programme covers the six units and offers the same pathway to certification and EMCC accreditation, with the option to continue with the PGC and Masters in Psychosynthesis Leadership Coaching. The London Programme (in-person) - September 2023

Certificate Programme 2 - 16 days of F2F workshops over 6 weekends + other online sessions

F2F workshops: (Bloomsbury): 15-17 Sept 2023, 13-15 Oct, 10-12 Nov, 08-10 Dec, 13-14 Jan 2024, 10-11 Feb. Times: 09:00-17:00 UK, except Friday's start at 10:00, Sundays end at 16:00.

Supervised practice period to EMCC Accreditation 9 months minimum, study period to PGC graduation 10 months.

The International Programme (online) - January 2024

Certificate Programme 3 - 16 days of online workshops over 6 weekends + other online sessions

Online workshops: 26-28 January 2024, 23-25 February, 22-24 March, 19-21 April, 18-19 May, 1-2 June 2024. Times: 09:00-17:00 UK. Sundays end at 16:00.

Supervised practice period to EMCC Accreditation 9 months minimum, study period to PGC graduation 17 months; (Middlesex University validation of this online version of the programme is in-process.)

Short Courses and HCP Programmes for 2023 and 2024

Foundational Professional Development Programmes for coaches, leading to certification and EMCC accreditation.

The Fundamentals of Psychosynthesis (within a coaching and leadership context) – 3-day online workshop. Online dates: 21-23 September 2023, 18-20 January 2024. Times: 09:00-17:00 UK each day.

Fee: £350 payable to The Institute of Psychosynthesis.

Introduction to Psychosynthesis as a Coaching Psychology (was Short Course 1) - 2-day online workshop.

Online dates: 9-10 May 2024. Times: 09:00-17:00 UK each day.

Fee: €400 (or £350 + VAT in the UK only).

Foundations of Psychosynthesis Coaching I (was Short Course 2) - 2-day online workshop.

Pre-requisites: to have attended either the **Introduction to Psychosynthesis** or the **Fundamentals of Psychosynthesis** (or equivalent) or an extended training in psychosynthesis.

Online dates: 19-20 October 2023, 15-16 February 2024, 6-7 June, 17-18 October. Times: 09:00-17:00 UK each day.

Fee: €400 (or £350 + VAT in the UK only).

Foundations of Psychosynthesis Coaching II (was Short Course 3) - 2-day online workshop.

Pre-requisites: Short Course 2. Introduction to Psychosynthesis Coaching.

Online dates: 16-17 November 2023, 14-15 March 2024, 4-5 July, 21-22 November. Times: 09:00-17:00 UK each day.

The Holistic Coaching Practitioner Programme

150 Hour Practitioner Accreditation Programme over 7 months (or longer to suit your pace and availability). Prior attendance of the *Foundations of Leadership Coaching I & II* required. An initial group orientation is followed by half day practice workshops, your own coaching practice, group supervision and tutor coaching support leading to EMCC Coach accreditation.

New programmes starting October 2023 and March 2024 (dates of orientation and practice workshops on request).

Fee: €2100 (£1800 + VAT in the UK only). The programme includes the following seven elements:

- (i) **Programme orientation and preparation** Half-day online group meeting. Context setting, organising supervision groups and peer coaching. Q&A about pro-bono practice, the EMCC accreditation process and any other topics.
- (ii) **Workshop coaching practice**, in triads and fishbowls: 4 x 4 hour sessions. Each half-day practice session will include a teaching topic, coaching demonstration, fishbowl coaching and coaching practice in triads.
- (iii) Peer coaching practice, 6 one-hour each way monthly sessions with a colleague in the group.
- (iv) **Pro-bono** (or paid client or internal client) **coaching practice**, 24 hours of sessions, over six months or longer if needed (self-organised or through one of our pro-bono projects).
- (v) **Group supervision**, 6 x 2 hour sessions (groups of 2-3) for your pro-bono or other coaching supervision.
- (vi) 1-to-1 Tutor Coach sessions x 5 support for your personal and professional development, leading to assessment and EMCC Accreditation.
- (vii) $\mbox{\bf Progress Reviews}$ these take place with your Tutor Coach as part of the above
- (viii) Learning Reflection Paper 2,500 Words, written near the end of the programme
- (ix) EMCC EIA Application Form This includes a 300-word personal statement which is part of the above.
