Introduction to our short courses and accreditation programme

This brochure describes PCL's **Short Courses** and the **Holistic Coaching Practitioner** programme that lead to coach **accreditation with the EMCC** and provides details of the courses scheduled for 2023 and 2024.

Empowered by our experience of running courses online using Zoom during the pandemic, these courses and programmes can all be attended online involving training workshops, group coaching practice, supervision sessions and one-to-one tutorials. From our strong foundations in Europe, we also now serve a global audience of coaches.

The short courses can be taken as **individual steps** of coach training and development, or they can be followed by the HCP programme that leads to EMCC Coach Accreditation.

They can serve as a training in the holistic psychological approach of **psychosynthesis** for experienced coaches looking coach at greater depth. You may also want to take one of our short courses before attending the longer CPLC programme (for more information, see our website: https://www.psychosynthesis-leadership-coaching/).

By choosing any of our coach development pathways you are affirming two significant choices:

The first is to recognise that meaningful professional coaching needs to be underpinned by a **holistic psychology** that engages your personal as well as professional development as a coach and involves working with the whole person, i.e. the coachees inner as well as outer life, their personal growth as well as outer goals and performance.

The second is to align with our **global accreditation partner**, the **EMCC**, whose holistic approach to accreditation places greater emphasis on quality training and development and less on the number of coaching hours. The EMCC are the leading coaching professional body in Europe and have led the establishment of the Professional Charter (established under EU law) as the foundation for self-regulation of the profession.



This course introduces the key principles, models, practices and processes of psychosynthesis as a coaching psychology. The online two-day workshop combines seminars, exercises, discussions and personal reflection to give you an understanding and experience of this holistic and integrative psychology, from the perspective of both holistic coaching and leadership coaching in organisations.







The Holistic Coaching Practitioner Programme

150 Hour Practitioner Accreditation Programme over 7 months (or longer to suit your pace). Prior attendance of the Foundations of Leadership Coaching I & II required. An initial group orientation is followed by half day practice workshops, your own coaching practice, group supervision and tutor coaching support leading to EMCC Coach accreditation.

New programmes starting March 2024 and November 2024 (dates of orientation and practice workshops on request).

Fee: €2100 (£1800 + VAT in the UK only). The programme includes the following elements:

- (i) **Programme orientation and preparation** Half-day online group meeting. Context setting, organising supervision groups and peer coaching. Q&A about pro-bono practice, the EMCC accreditation process and any other topics.
- (ii) **Workshop coaching practice**, in triads and fishbowls: 4 x 4 hour sessions. Each half-day practice session will include a skills teaching topic, coaching demonstration, fishbowl coaching and coaching practice in triads.
- (iii) Peer coaching practice, 6 one-hour each way monthly sessions with a colleague in the group.
- (iv) **Pro-bono** (or paid client or internal client) **coaching practice**, 24 hours of sessions, over six months or longer if needed (self-organised or through one of our pro-bono projects).
- (v) Group supervision, 6 x 2 hour sessions (groups of 2-3) for your pro-bono or other coaching supervision.
- (vi) 1-to-1 Tutor Coach sessions x 5 support for your personal and professional development, leading to assessment and EMCC Accreditation.
- (vii) Progress Reviews these take place with your Tutor Coach as part of the above
- (viii) Learning Reflection Paper 2,500 Words, written near the end of the programme
- (ix) EMCC EIA Application Form This includes a 300-word personal statement which is part of the above.
