## Introduction

This new five-month programme is designed for practising coaches who want to work at greater depth. As well as graduates of Psychosynthesis Coaching Limited's CPLC and HCP programmes, we will also consider applications from other accredited coaches (e.g. with EMCC, ICF, AC or APECS), who have relevant previous training and experience, as well as psychosynthesis trained counsellors and therapists who are practising coaches.

This first programme takes place in-person in London, starting February 2026. The course takes you on a personal and professional psychosynthesis journey of depth and discovery.

# Structure of the Programme

5 x two-day weekend seminars, supported by small group reflection sessions, webinars and online materials. The broad scope of these are:

- 1. The Self and personality sacred wound and the inner child; disidentification, subpersonalities and the I-Self
- 2. The Will psychological functions and the will; aspects, qualities, levels and stages of the Act of Will; the nature of free will
- 3. The Soul's journey the journey of the soul, the nature of suffering, psychological disturbance, crisis and breakdown
- **4. Spiritual emergence, awakening and crisis** crises of meaning and duality, Assagioli's four stages of awakening, psychological mountain climbing and transpersonal inspiration
- Synthesis and polarity interplay of polarity and opposites; inner and outer, individual and collective; concrete and abstract mind; the process of synthesis at different levels; synthesis for leadership in a VUCA world.

## Context

The course takes you on a newly designed personal and professional journey into psychosynthesis psychology, over five weekend workshops. The aim is to both enable participants to experience Assagioli's core concepts of psychosynthesis and to bring this psychospiritual psychology into relationship with the world we engage with today as practitioners, coaches and leaders. Each weekend workshop is facilitated by a different experienced psychosynthesis trainer alongside Aubyn Howard and Bonny Tydeman, as guides of the overall journey.


## **Course Content Overview**

# Going to Depth with Psychosynthesis Psychology

The five seminars are being developed with the guest facilitators for each one – the following provides an overview of the topics and territory of this new and unique journey.

## Self and Personality: 2-day seminar with Theo Dijkman

- Self and personality formation
- Incarnation and the sacred wound
- Identification and disidentification



### Act of Will: 2-day seminar with Anne Welsh

- Transpersonal Will, Free Will and Agency
- The Act of Will as a depth coaching model revisited
- Assagioli's Star diagram developing the psychological functions and related aspects of will

We explore the Will as a central concept of psychosynthesis, using experiential exercises, self-reflection and dialogue to explore the distinction between the Will of the Self and the will of our subpersonalities. What do we mean by and how can we experience free will or agency in a VUCA world, variously characterised in terms of systemic forces and structural determinism, power and control, victimhood and despair? We turn to how the depth coach supports the development of will by their coachees, how the will can be healthily expressed in all its aspects through the psychological functions; thinking, feeling, sensation, intuition, imagination and desire.

#### Soul's Journey: 2-day seminar with Theo Dijkman

- The call of Self and the journey of the Soul
- The developmental journey of becoming
- Psychological disturbance, crisis and breakdown

The focus of this seminar is an exploration of what drives the human psyche and considers this to be determined by an inner knowing, a call of Self, rather than being driven by a historical narrative. The human psyche is on a constant journey of engagement with and development through relationships with others and the world around it. This journey can at times be unsettling and disturbing. The natural response to this is to cure the unsettledness, to calm the disturbance. A psychosynthesis approach is engaging with this as a process rather than as a cure in which breakdown can become a breakthrough.







### Spiritual Emergence: 2-day seminar with Jessica Nelson

- Spiritual emergence and emergency
- Assagioli's four stages of awakening
- Psychological mountain climbing



This seminar explores – in interactive ways – Psychosynthesis concepts relating to psychological evolution beyond Self-Actualization towards Self-Realization (Spiritual Awakening). Models include Firman and Vargiu's Dimensions of Growth, Assagioli's 4 Stages of Awakening and his Psychological 'Mountain-Climbing' metaphor. Some life experiences and crises may have a spiritual origin and can be worked with to harness effectively higher qualities such as Intuition, Creativity and Inspiration (Spiritual Emergence). However, not all 'spiritual awakening' occurs in a well-integrated personality. Over the weekend, we will begin to distinguish between healthy Spiritual Emergence and more extreme psychological disturbances which can occur in a Spiritual Emergency.

## Synthesis and Polarity: 2-day seminar with Keith Silvester

- Liquid modernity and the way we now experience change
- Concrete and abstract mind finding a new pattern for a VUCA world
- Polarity and synthesis, evolution of consciousness



We complete our journey by returning to Assagioli's core concepts of *Polarity and Synthesis* and *Unity in Diversity*, seeking to bring these into relationship with the VUCA world as we encounter and experience it today. We set this inquiry within the context of societal shifts in consciousness and social evolution, and the relationship between individual and collective consciousness. We explore how the interplay of concrete/linear mind and abstract/intuitive mind is key to reframing problems, discovering unseen options or resources and finding systemic solutions when working with leaders, teams, groups and organisational systems.

#### Reflective practice and personal integration

The weekend workshops are supported by small group reflective practice sessions that take place in between the workshops. These provide an opportunity to personally and professionally reflect and integrate the experience from the weekends, e.g. by asking ourselves:

- How does this topic impact or inform my experience of self, my growth and development, my shadow and potential?
- How might it come into the coaching and leadership space with individuals, teams and systems, with families and communities?
- How does it inform my sense making about what is emergent in the wider system at different levels?
- How can it inform my understanding of the dynamics in play and the interventions I make as a practitioner?

From 2009-2017 he was also Chair of Training Standards of the Humanistic and Integrative College of UKCP. From 1993-2003 he was Head of the Counselling and Advisory Service of the Central School of Speech and Drama in London. A graduate of the



University of Cambridge, he has an MSc in Training from Leicester University. He is a qualified community worker and Alexander Technique practitioner.
